They are often used ornamentally in urban and suburban settings and can be found growing naturally throughout most of the U.S. These trees typically blossom in spring and allergenic, the pollen would be very difficult to avoid for sensitive individuals. It is best to check pollen levels during spring months. Be sure to keep windows and doors closed and un air-conditioning as much as possible.
